Jennifer Pierce-Weeks RN, SANE-A, SANE-P is President of the International Association of Forensic Nurses and has served on the IAFN Board since 2006. Jennifer is presently Coordinator of the Forensic Nurse Examiner at Memorial Health System in Colorado Springs, and previously served for 12 years as the Director of the State of NH Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner Program. She has 23 years nursing experience, and is an educator and expert in the areas of child and adult sexual assault.

Donna Kelly, JD works as a Deputy County Attorney in the Utah County Special Victims' Unit prosecuting adult and child sex crimes. She has spent most of her 27-year career as an attorney as a felony prosecutor. Since 1990, she has prosecuted primarily child abuse and sex crimes, and has done well over 100 felony jury trials. In 1999 she was one of the first prosecutors in Oregon to obtain a conviction at trial under Oregon's revised child homicide statute.
